

# FACT SHEET : ONLINE CERTIFICATE 2/BRONZE MEDALLION

## HISTORY

Surf Life Saving has been training members in the Bronze Medallion since its inception in 1907. This award is central to our history, our traditions and our organisation.

In 2004 there was a change in this award – with the addition of a Certificate II Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue).

## CURRENT

When members seek to join a club and patrol they then embark on training for the Bronze Medallion/ PUA21012 Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue),

The training for this course will last for approximately 40 hours face to face depending on current skills and knowledge and fitness levels, and incorporate all theoretical and practical knowledge towards set learning outcomes.


Members now have the opportunity to do the theory component on line.

### 1. SLSA MEMBERS PORTAL ACCOUNT

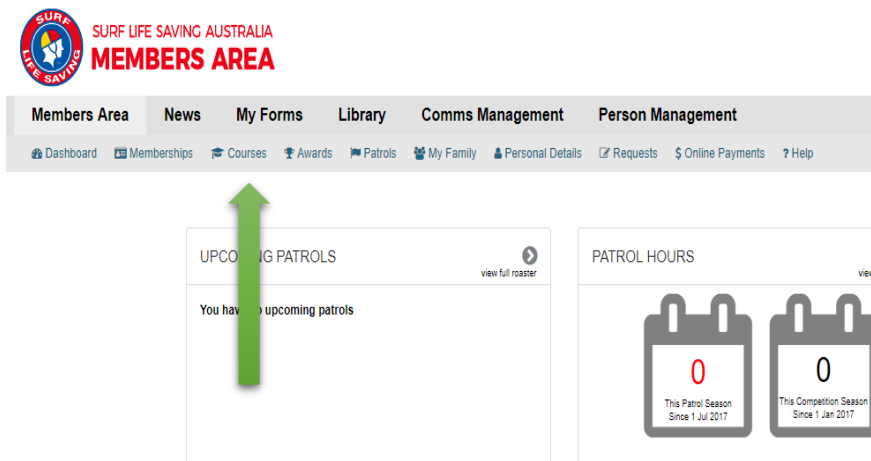

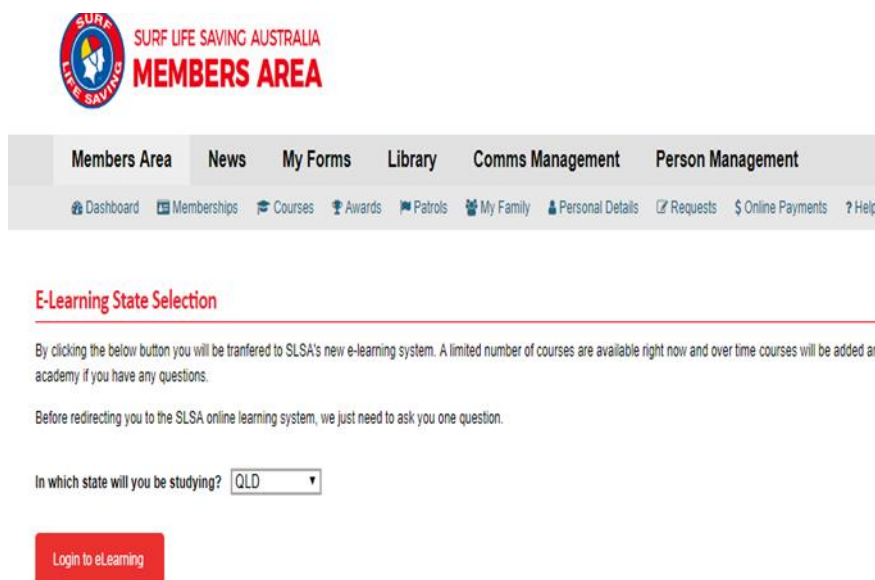

## 2. FIND ON-LINE COURSE

Select "Courses" on the sub menu



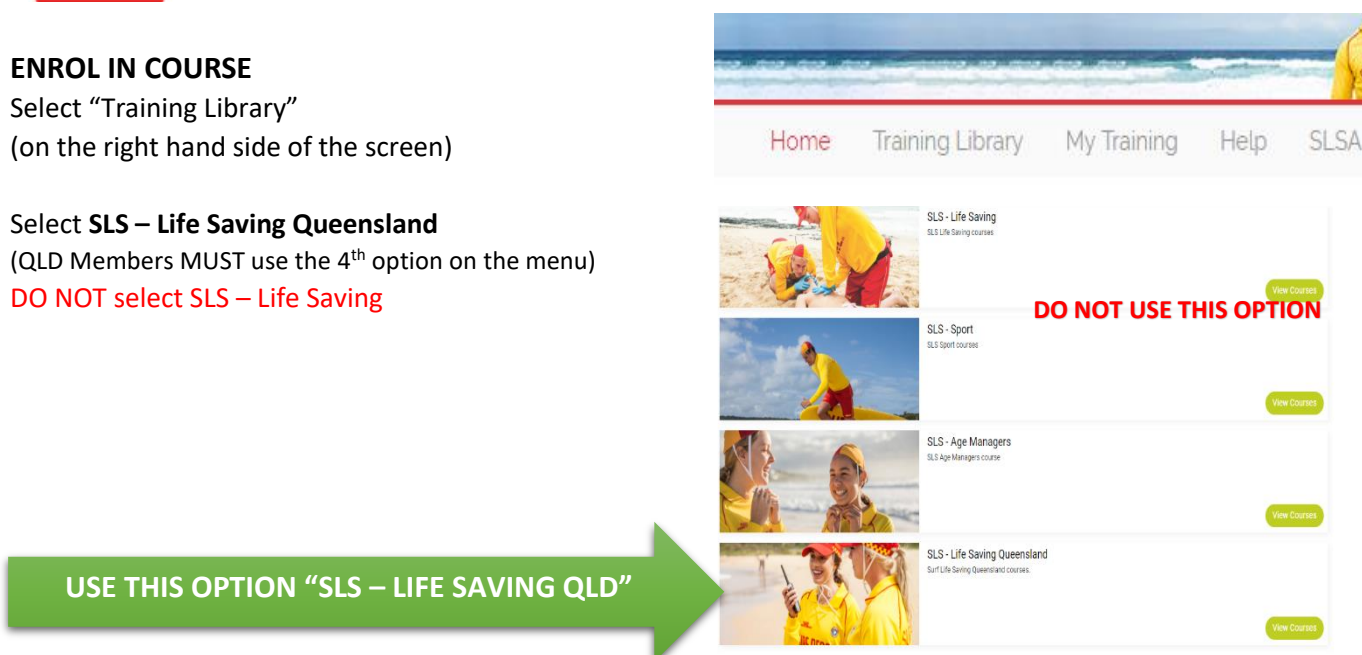
Select your State "QLD" and then select "Login into E-Learning"



## 3. ENROL IN COURSE

Select "Training Library"  
(on the right hand side of the screen)

Select **SLS – Life Saving Queensland**  
(QLD Members MUST use the 4<sup>th</sup> option on the menu)  
**DO NOT** select SLS – Life Saving



#### 4. COMPLETE COURSE

Once you have completed the course you will download a Certificate of Completion. You MUST print this and take with you and hand to your Trainer.

#### 5. COMPLETE ASSESSMENT PORTFOLIO

Your club/trainer should provide you with an Assessment Portfolio – this will include the following items

- Candidate details (including your signature)
- Induction Checklist (to be signed by the trainer)
- Incident Report Form (your trainer will give you a scenario and you must complete the form)
- Assessment Task 2, 3 and 4 (these will be completed by your trainer and/or assessor throughout the course and on assessment day)
